

ARMY MORNING REPORTS SOP (Standard Operating Procedure) June 1, 1944

One of the best resources to find information about someone who served in the U.S. Army is through what is known as morning reports. As the name suggests, these were reports produced every morning in Army units, relating to personnel matters, usually by the company clerk, signed off on then by the company commander. These reports detail on a daily basis who is present for duty, army personnel who are on leave, detached duty, in the hospital, those who have been promoted or disciplined, and offer much more information. They are an excellent means for learning about the day-to-day activity of Army units and can fill in a lot of gaps of information about an individual soldier or officer. Particularly with the personnel files damaged in the 1973 fire at the National Personnel Records Center, the morning reports can provide supplementary information that can be quite vital for the procurement of benefits, give documentation for medals and awards honored, or give a clearer picture of the military and war-time experiences of family members who served. Though the filing of morning reports ceased in the mid-1970s, they were produced by the Army up until then. The Morning Reports for the twentieth century are available at NPRC and at the National Archives in Washington, DC for periods before 1900. With researchers at both facilities, we can retrieve these for you, enabling you to have documentary evidence of military service.

Interpreting the morning reports entails a little deciphering, as abbreviations are frequently used. The Administrative SOP produced by the 104th Infantry Division in June, 1944, based on War Department regulations of the time which we present here is a very helpful guide to understanding the information. This was created to instruct company clerks on how to fill out the reports, but it is particularly helpful to researchers in reading and comprehending the reports these many years

later. This guide, then, is an important tool in helping to construct the military service of an Army serviceman or woman.

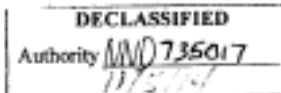

CHECK LIST FOR MORNING REPORTS
(AR 345-400)

SECTION I, GENERAL

1. The proper day, month, and year for twenty-four hour period being reported on will be indicated at the top of the page. (Par 8)
2. The complete designation of organization as shown in the appropriate 1, 0 and its location will be entered on the appropriate lines. (Par 8b)
3. The arm or service of the organization will be entered to the right of the organization designation.
4. The remarks entered will cover all changes occurring between 0000 and 2400 of the date entered at top of Morning Report. (Par 3)
5. All abbreviations used will conform with AR 850-150. (Par 4b)
6. When keeping a multi-page report, the pages will be properly numbered. Example: If a two-page report, the first page will be numbered "Page 1 of 2 Pages," second page will be numbered "Page 2 of 2 pages." (Par 4b)
7. The original and both copies of the Morning Report will be authenticated by the commanding officer, or by the unit personnel officer when made up from Morning Report extracts in the field. Morning Reports of headquarters will be authenticated by the commanding officer or an officer designated by the commanding officer. The third copy (green) will be initialed by the personnel officer as certification that the entries have been accurately transcribed. (Par 42)
8. Erasures will not be made. Incorrect entries will be properly deleted and initialed by the officer signing the report. (Par 5)
9. The ASN, grade, and name of each individual entered on the Morning Report will be checked at Unit Personnel Section for accuracy against the Service Record before forwarding the Morning Report.
10. The yellow copy of the Morning Report will be retained in the reporting organization until instructions are issued by the Adjutant General for disposition of such copies. (Par 6c)
11. The green copy will be initialed by the personnel officer and retained in the unit personnel section until instructions are issued by the Adjutant General for disposition of such copies. (Par 6c, and c)

SECTION II, REMARKS

1. a. Remarks reporting personnel gained as assigned or attached unassigned will include:
 - (1) Whether assigned or attached unassigned.

- (2) Whether or not individual has joined. (jd, enroute to join, or not yet jd.)
 - (3) Unit from which assigned or attached unassigned.
 - (4) MOS with degree of skill (skilled or semi-skilled).
 - (5) Duty (officers only) if known at time of assignment. (Title and code number from TM 12-406 or TM 12-407, as applicable.)
 - (6) MCO.
 - (7) Limited Service, when applicable.
 - (8) Race.
 - (9) Component (officers only).
 - (10) Authority (Headquarters, Special Orders number, and paragraph number). (Par 11 and 12)
2. Remarks reporting an individual attached from other organizations will include:
- a. Statement that individual is attached and name and location of organization from which attached.
 - b. Whether joined.
 - c. If not joined, the reason not joined.
 - d. Purpose of attachment.
 - e. Duty (officers only) if known at time of attachment. (Title and Code Number from TM 12-406 or TM 12-407, as applicable. (Par 13)
3. When an individual's basic status is attached unassigned or attached from another organization, the basic status will be included each and every time the individual's name is reported on the morning report. (Par 9c)
4. a. Only the highest MOS of enlisted men will be reported on the Morning Report, after the company commander has rated the enlisted man as semi-skilled or skilled. (Ltr XVI Corps, 5 July 44)
- b. Whenever an entry is made that requires the MOS be shown, the degree of skill, skilled or semi-skilled, will be indicated. In addition, any change in degree of skill will be made on the Morning Report indicating corresponding MOS. (Ltr XVI Corps, 5 July 44)
5. In each case where a new principal duty has been recorded for an officer under item 15 on WD AGO Form 66-1, an appropriate remark will be entered on the Morning Report stating last previous duty, new duty

- with code number, and date of entry on new duty. This remark will be made immediately on the Morning Report and not delayed until it can be made on monthly personnel roster; (Par 31)
6. a. In all cases of transfer; the authority for transfer, and the organization and station to which transferred will be shown.
b. Statement if individual has departed, or not departed. If "Not Departed", reason and/or status. If "Departed", date of departure.
c. Statement of effective date of change as indicated in special order transferring individual.
d. Individuals will be dropped from strength section of Morning Report on effective date of change. (Par 14, AR 345-400 and See IX, Cir 272/44)
 7. a. When an individual is placed on detached service the organization and station where such duty is performed, and authority for change will be indicated. For return from detached service the organization and station where detached service has been performed. (Par 16)
b. Statement indicating relief from principal duty, if applicable. (Officers only.) (Par 16)
 8. a. When an individual is placed on temporary duty the remark will include:
 - (1) Statement of departure for temporary duty.
 - (2) Organizations or places where temporary duty is to be performed.
 - (3) The approximate duration of temporary duty, if known. (Par 17)
b. Remark covering return from temporary duty will read, "Temp dy to dy". (Par 17c(2))
 9. The proper determination will be made as to detached service, temporary duty, and special duty in all cases as defined in Section IV, Morning Report terms, below.
 10. When reporting an individual from duty to leave or furlough, the authorized number of days of absence will be included in remarks. Upon return to duty, the actual number of days absent will be indicated. (Par 19)
 11. When reporting an individual as AWOL, both the day and the hour of departure and return will be included in remarks. (Par 20)
 12. a. The name and location of the hospital will be indicated in remarks covering departure and return from hospital except for hospitalization at the same station to which organization is assigned. (Par 18)

- b. Hospital station assigned will be designated, "Sta Hosp".
13. When reporting an individual in confinement the remark will include:
 - a. Statement that individual is in arrest or confinement.
 - b. Statement of nature of alleged offense and place of confinement.
 - c. Whether the individual is being held for trial, has been tried, or has been dismissed without trial, or when tried, whether acquitted or convicted.
 - d. Return to duty status when applicable. (Par 22)
14. The word "absent" will be omitted for remarks covering sickness and confinement, as all such cases (including sk in 105th Clearing Co) are carried in the absent columns of the strength section except those "sk in qrs" and "conf in qrs".
15. All remarks concerning sickness, death, other than battle casualties, will include the notation as to "LD" or "LD-No". If "LD-No" is entered, "AR 35-1440", "AW 107", "RPTS", or similar entry as appropriate will be entered. (Par 18b(3) and (5))
16. Record of events will be entered on Morning Reports on the 10th, 20th, and the last day of each month, and in addition, as events warrant. (Par 33)
17. In all cases of remarks covering other than routine changes, a clear and complete picture will be given.
18. For all changes which occurred prior to the date covered by the Morning Report, the date of change will be indicated in the remark. (Par 10b)

SECTION III, STRENGTH SECTION

1. The strength section of the Morning Report will reflect the strength status of each reporting unit, as of 2400 at the close of the morning report day. (Par 39a)
2. The figures in the strength section will reflect the changes shown in remarks. (Par 39b)
3. If more than one set of forms is required for remarks, strength figures will be entered only on the final set. (Par 39d)
4. All individuals will be carried either in the "duty" column or in the "absent" columns except those sick in quarters or in arrest in quarters, who should be carried "present not for duty".
5. Diagonal lines will be used to separate the total master sergeants from total first sergeants; staff sergeants from technicians 3d grade;

sergeants from technicians 4th grade; corporals from technicians 5th grade. In all cases totals for first sergeants, technicians 3d, 4th, and 5th grades; will be indicated to the right of the diagonal line.

6. In order to comply with the provisions of AR 345-400, dated 1 May 1944, in the preparation of Morning Reports; and still show Unit Mail Clerks in assigned positions, one additional Technician 5th Grade will be shown in the assigned column of the Morning Report, and one less Private will be carried in the assigned column in all companies or similar units where the Unit Mail Clerk is performing this duty in addition to his other duties and is rated as Technician 5th Grade.

SECTION IV, MORNING REPORT TERMS

1. Assigned Personnel: All personnel made members of an organization and filling a T/O vacancy. (Par 11)
2. Attached Unassigned: Personnel not carried on the strength of any other unit and not assigned as described in preceding paragraph. (Par 12)
3. Attached: Personnel attached; by orders, for duty with one organization but remain assigned members of another organization. (Par 13)
4. Detached Service: An individual will be reported on detached service when performing duty for, and being administered by, an organization other than that to which assigned or attached unassigned. (Par 16)
5. Temporary Duty: An individual is on temporary duty when absent from the unit or station of assignment, performing duty incident to regular duties, and being administered by the organization to which assigned or attached unassigned. (Par 17)
6. a. Special Duty: An individual is on special duty when performing duty for another unit and reporting daily to the unit to which assigned, attached unassigned, or attached from another organization. (Par 15)
- b. Special Duty is not reported on any Morning Report. Individuals on special duty are carried present for duty.
